

PULL HANDLE REPLACEMENT

Tools Needed:

- Phillips screwdriver
- Allen wrench



Step 2: Using the rubber mallet, tap upwards on the pull handle bar then lift up to remove pull handle off.



Step 3: Install the new pull handle. Glide pull handle into guides making sure screw holes are in align. Insert and tighten the 4 screws circled in red.



The End: Congratulations, you have successfully replaced the pull handle!

Step 1: Loosen the upper joints. Unscrew the 4 screws indicated by the red arrows.

Illustration: If needed, use the rubber mallet and gently tap down on pull handle bar till in place then insert screws.
